

Griffith Health International – Woolworths Voucher Prize Draw Terms & Conditions

In appreciation of students providing feedback on their experience through the 'Mid-Trimester Check-in survey, Griffith Health International offers exciting Woolworths Voucher prizes to students.

Terms and Conditions

1. By electing to completing Section 21 of the Mid-Trimester Check-in survey, you accept these terms and conditions of the prize draw. Instructions on how to enter the draw and details regarding the advertising of the survey form part of the conditions. Any personal information you provide to the University in the course of entering the prize draw will be dealt with by the University in accordance with the [Griffith University Privacy Plan](#).
2. The prize draws are conducted by Griffith Health International, Learning and Teaching (Health Group), Griffith University.
3. There will be one major round of Woolworth Voucher prize draw per calendar year. The Survey will close on Friday 13th of September 11:59pm. The draw will be conducted on Monday 16th of September 7:00am. Winners will be notified after draw has been conducted. Mid-Trimester Check-in surveys are not conducted for all University groups.
4. Entry is free (other than the cost of accessing the website, which is your responsibility).
5. To enter the prize draw for a particular round, you must:
 - a) be an international student, with a temporary resident status; and
 - b) be enrolled in an eligible program after the “census date” for the entirety of the Trimester;
 - c) answer all ‘Likert-Scale’ questions on the Mid-Trimester Check-in survey; and
 - d) submit the completed Section 21 of the Mid-Trimester Check-in survey through Microsoft Forms, before the survey deadline (as shown on the “Mid-Trimester Check-in” email).
6. You may only submit one survey. Response submissions are final, and entries close at 11:59pm (AEST) on the survey deadline date.
7. You will receive one entry into the prize draw for your completed Survey submitted.
8. Subject to system malfunction, the draw will be conducted on Monday 16th of September 7:00am. If the Microsoft Forms is not functioning as it should when the draw is due, the draw will be held as soon as possible once the form becomes functional again. Prize winners do not need to be present at the time of the draw.
9. Prize winners will be selected randomly from valid entries received. Each entry can only be drawn once.
10. A message will be placed on the homepage of the Griffith Health International page advising that the prize draw has occurred. However, names and other details of prize winners will not be published.

11. The Griffith Health International will attempt to contact prize winners, by email, using contact details entered into the form.
12. Instructions on how to claim the prize will be included in the email sent to each winner.
13. The right to a prize is not transferable or assignable to another person.
14. If any prize winner cannot be contacted within three (3) months of the draw, or does not complete the necessary steps to collect their prize by the deadline notified in the University's email, then that person's right to the prize is forfeited and the prize will be treated as an unclaimed prize.
15. Only one redraw of unclaimed prizes will take place, and other existing prizes are not affected. The redraw prize winner(s) will be randomly selected from remaining valid entries and notified within two (2) weeks of the redraw. If the redraw prize winner(s) cannot be contacted within three (3) months of the redraw, then the University may determine that the relevant prize(s) will not be awarded.
16. The University will not be liable for any loss, expense, damage or injury sustained by any entrant in connection with this prize draw, the prize or redemption of the prize, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law (in which case, that liability is limited to the minimum allowable by law).
17. The University may suspend the promotion if it determines that the integrity or administration of the promotion has been adversely affected due to circumstances beyond its control. The University may disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process.
