### Do I have to attend Orientation?



### **Getting to Griffith**

Mt Gravatt campus is located less than 15 minutes by car from the centre of Brisbane and within walking distance of the South East Bus way. Buses also connect direct to the city.

### By Bus

### By Train

The closest train station to Nathan and Mt Gravatt campus is Salisbury. This station is situated west of both campuses and is approximately 12 minutes by bus.

### By Taxi

### By Car
