

CONFERENCE SUPPORT SCHEME

The Australian Centre for Human Evolution (ARCHE) understands the importance of establishing and developing external relationships, collaborative opportunities and promoting our research at conferences and similar events. The Conference Support Scheme offers financial support to members when representing the Centre at national or international conferences, workshops or symposiums.

This scheme is offered to **Early Career Researchers (ECR)** and **Higher Degree by Research (HDR) candidates** who meet the following conditions. To be eligible as an ECR, you must be a Core member of the Centre and have completed your PhD within the last 5 years. To be eligible as an HDR, you must be enrolled in an HDR program in the School of Environment and Science at Griffith University, have a member of the Centre as your principal or associate supervisor, and be undertaking a research project aligned with the Research program of the Centre.

Individuals from other member categories may be considered on a case by case basis.

AWARD:

- ARCHE will provide funding of up to \$750.00 for national conferences and up to \$2,000 for international conferences.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must be participating in the conference as either presenting author of an oral paper or coordinator of a symposium/workshop;
- Applicant must provide letter or email including evidence abstract has been accepted and also identifying the applicant as a speaker or coordinator;
- Applicant must be attending the conference in person;
- Applicant must list ARCHE as their primary academic address (evidence required).

RESTRICTIONS:

- The amount awarded is at the discretion of ARCHE; and
- A maximum of one (1) national and one (1) international conference will be funded per individual.

AVAILABILITY:

- The Conference Support Scheme is offered to eligible members throughout each calendar year subject to funding availability; and
- There is no set closing date for this scheme; members can submit applications at any time.
