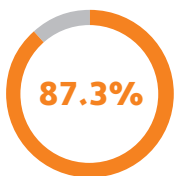

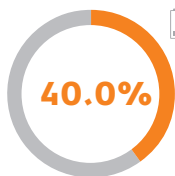
“Overall, how satisfied are you with the quality of your higher degree by research experience?”

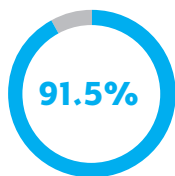

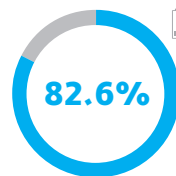

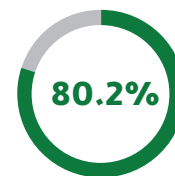


My supervisor demonstrates respect for me as a person.

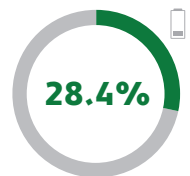


My supervisors provide feedback in a timely manner.

### Skills development

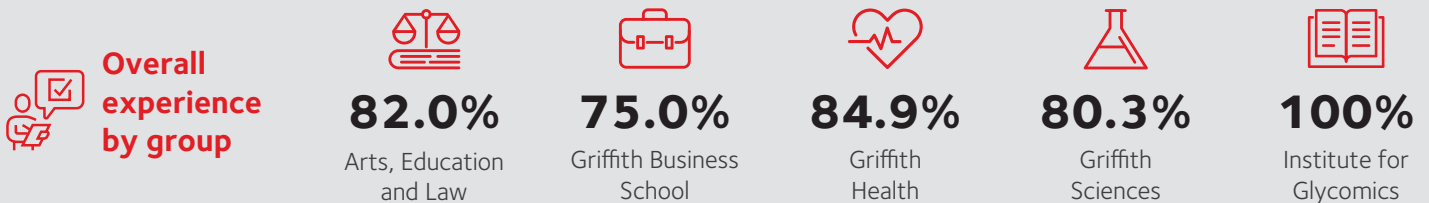


I am aware of the skills that I am developing through my research that can be applied outside of academia.

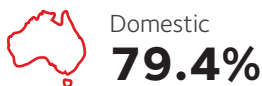
