Do I have to attend Orientation?

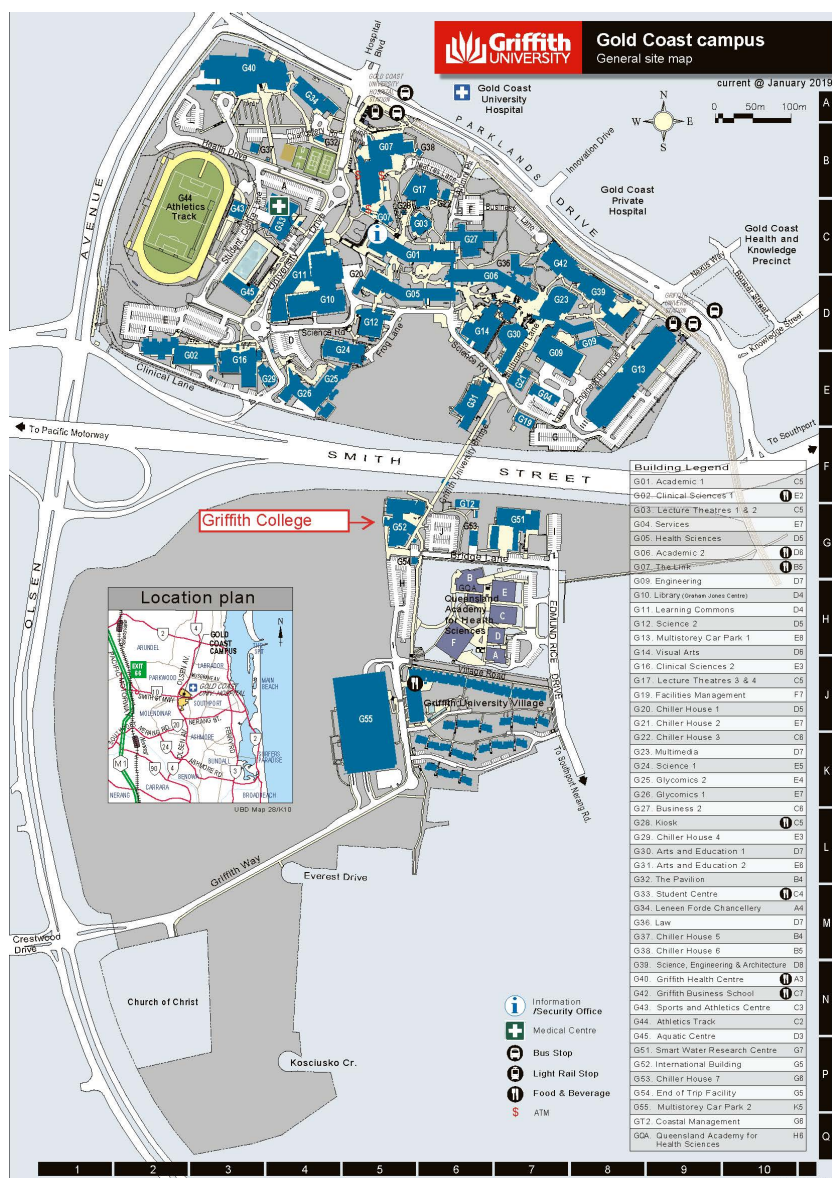

Getting to Griffith

The Gold Coast campus is centrally located in Southport, just north of Surfers Paradise, and is easily accessible by train, bus, bicycle and car. The closest airport is located at Coolangatta which is a 40 minute drive south of the campus. To access Griffith College from the main Griffith campus, walk to building G52 via the Griffith University Bridge on the southern side of the campus.

By Bus and Train

You can reach the Gold Coast campus by bus or train. Helensvale is the closest train station, and is about 15 minutes by car or 20 minutes by bus to the Gold Coast campus. Trains to Brisbane and Robina can be boarded at this station. Bus connections run between Robina station, Helensvale station and the Gold Coast campus.

By Light Rail

The Gold Coast Light Rail, G:Link, has two stops on campus, providing students with a rapid and easy transport option to and from the heart of the Gold Coast. The G:Link line begins at the Gold Coast University Hospital, travels south through Southport, Surfers Paradise and Broadbeach, and terminates at Pacific Fair shopping centre. By Car

Day parking is available at the multi-storey car park G55 (Griffith Way) at a cost of \$8.00 per hour, payable through a ticketing machine at the car park.
