Look no further! The Institute for Glycomics is now offering an exciting scholarship opportunity.

### About the Scholarship:

This prestigious scholarship aims to provide three talented Doctor of Medicine students commencing in 2023/2024 with hands-on research experience in cutting-edge biomedical research projects in the areas of cancer, infectious diseases, or neurological diseases. As a scholarship recipient, you will have the opportunity to work closely with renowned researchers and contribute to ground-breaking advancements in these crucial fields.

- The scholarship requires students to commit a minimum of 145 hours to their research project over 12 months. The successful candidates will be required to submit an interim report and a final report upon the completion of the project.
- Value: \$8000 per student. The payment will be disbursed in two instalments: 50% upon commencement of the project and the remaining 50% upon satisfactory completion of the interim report, once half of the required hours have been completed.
- Level of Study: Postgraduate (by coursework)
- Duration: Maximum of 12 months
- Location: Institute for Glycomics

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The applicant must be enrolled full-time students in Year 1 or Year 2 of Griffith University's Doctor of Medicine programs,
- The applicant should have formal research experience, eg hold an Honours/Master's degree, or demonstrate equivalent research experience,
- The applicant must maintain a pass grade in all courses,
- The applicant will select a research project relevant to cancer, infectious diseases, and neurodegenerative disorders with approved supervisors, within the Institute for Glycomics. ## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Expression of interest cover letter for the scholarship and a statement of why you are a suitable candidate.
- Resume/CV detailing your educational background, research experience, and relevant skills.
- Academic transcripts from your Doctor of Medicine program and other completed programs

- Two supporting letters from academic or research professionals who can speak to your abilities and potential.
