



# Making the most of your preferences

## Bachelor of Physiotherapy

*To make the most of your preferences it is important to include pathways or related programs as options.*

If you are interested in a career in Physiotherapy the most direct route is via the Bachelor of Physiotherapy, however competition for limited places means that talented applicants miss out every year.

Applicants can undertake further study to improve their chances of receiving an offer to study the Bachelor of Physiotherapy by

- Completing 80 CP in a bachelor program at Griffith University **OR**
- one year fulltime equivalent bachelor level study at a recognised higher education institution **AND**
- achieving a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 5.5 or above (on a 7 point scale).

This can be achieved through another program from any discipline, however recommended options include the Bachelor of Exercise Science, Bachelor of Biomedical Science and Bachelor of Health Science.

Please note that the GPA 5.5 is a guide only, and for each intake the minimum Selection Rank will depend on the quality of the applicant pool.

*NB: once you have completed your further study you will need to reapply for the Bachelor of Physiotherapy through QTAC or UAC.*

Apply for registration as a Physiotherapist in Australia (subject to eligibility criteria)



Alternative pathways to the Bachelor of Physiotherapy:

- ▶ Bachelor of Exercise Science
- ▶ Bachelor of Biomedical Science
- ▶ Bachelor of Health Science
- ▶ Another undergraduate program.

*Admission via these programs is subject to meeting eligibility criteria.*

# Preferencing examples

## Applicant A

### Received OP 4

In this example, the applicant is eligible for an offer into their third preference. They could conditionally accept this offer and wait to be considered for a higher preference in the later offer rounds. If they don't receive an offer into a higher preference, they can accept their offer into the Bachelor of Biomedical Science as a pathway to the Bachelor of Physiotherapy.

### Received OP 14

In this example, the applicant is eligible for an offer into their fourth preference. They can accept their offer into the Bachelor of Exercise Science as a pathway to the Bachelor of Physiotherapy.
