

Budgeting for Global Internships

When preparing for a global internship, it is important for you to consider how much it will cost so you can budget accordingly. In general, we estimate that you should have access to around \$10,000 for one trimester. However, it is important to note that this is an estimate only and your actual expenses will vary significantly depending on program, destination, and other lifestyle factors.

You can use the following table as a starting point for your research.
