1. Register for an iLearn account at <https://ilearn.health.qld.gov.au/d2l/login>. Scroll down and click on 'Register here for an iLearn account'.

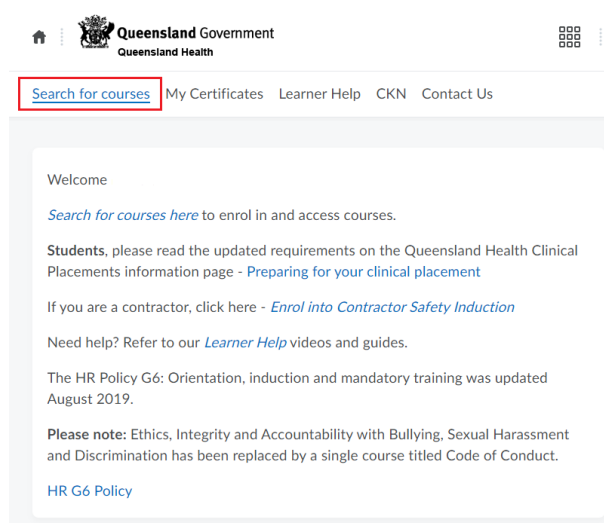



If you are using a mobile device you must enable cookies and cross-site tracking. If either of these are prevented or disabled you will not be able to launch the module.


