

All students must complete online modules before commencing a placement within a Queensland Health facility. You will not be able to commence your placement until your online modules are completed.

How do I complete the Queensland Health Orientation Online Training?

1. Register for an iLearn account at https://ilearn.health.qld.gov.au/d2l/login. Scroll down and click on 'Register here for an iLearn account'.

You will need to register as a 'student' and include your Placements Officer or Course Convenor as your 'Supervisor Contact'. If you are unsure of these details, please contact the Placements Officer in your School.

NOTE: You must have popups enabled on your preferred web browser eg MS Edge, Chrome, Firefox. If popups are prevented or disabled you will not be able to launch the module.

If you are using a mobile device you must enable cookies and cross-site tracking. If either of these are prevented or disabled you will not be able to launch the module.

Queensland Health Building Emergency Procedures Mandatory Training	First-Response Evacuation Instructions (FREI) This training provides an overview of instructions about the method and operation for manually operated fire alarms and fire-fighting equipment in a building. Applicable only to employees who do not have access to the online building specific emergency procedures for their work area. This training is Ongoing Occupational Violence Orientation (awareness only) This awareness training video provides information outlining early intervention, prevention, descalation and avoidance of occupational violence incidents.
