



VET pathways

Griffith recognises the skills and knowledge gained through Vocational Education and Training (VET) as a highly effective pathway to university.

We will continue to accept stand-alone VET qualifications completed at high school, private providers, and TAFE for admission in 2019 and 2020. We also encourage high school students to achieve an OP or ATAR.

Certificates III and IV

Certificates I and II are not assessed for university admission.

A completed Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) Certificate III or IV, undertaken while at high school, TAFE or through a private provider, will allow you to apply to study a range of degrees at Griffith University.

With the exception of the Certificate IV in Adult Tertiary Preparation, a Certificate III or IV does not meet the English subject prerequisite. For admission in 2019 and 2020, the English prerequisite can be satisfied by achieving a grade of Sound Achievement in four semesters of Senior English. If you undertook Year 12 interstate, your previous study may also meet the English prerequisite.

If you did not undertake Year 12, you may wish to complete the Griffith Personal Statement or Griffith Tertiary Preparation in order to meet the English prerequisite. Further information about these programs and bridging courses is available at griffith.edu.au/pathways

Diplomas and Advanced Diplomas

A completed AQF Diploma or Advanced Diploma, undertaken while at high school, TAFE or through a private provider, meets the English subject prerequisite for admission and will allow you to apply for a number of Griffith undergraduate degrees.

If you complete your Diploma qualification at TAFE, the TAFE Admission Pathway will allow you to apply for direct admission into the next intake of a number of Griffith undergraduate degrees. Although you may have completed your Year 12 study 5, 10 or 20 years ago, your OP or TE Score may still be current and may be used to admit you to Griffith University.
