Avoid Single-Use Decorations

Use reusable fabric or crepe paper bunting, tablecloths, streamers and paper flowers to decorate your stall rather than balloons and other single-use plastics.

Dispose Waste Correctly

Always attempt to produce zero-waste however, when required, utilise the general waste and recycling bins on campus to dispose of your waste correctly. Separate any soft plastics and dispose of at Coles or Woolworths REDcycle bins. Stallholders are required to only to bring recyclable serveware on campus, all plastic serveware is discouraged

Source Local Materials

Purchase locally made materials and products for your stall to help cut carbon emissions and air pollution due to the reduced distance travelled.

Provide Sustainable Giveaways

Where possible, choose products for your giveaways that support sustainable behaviour such as shopping tote bags, drink bottles or reusable coffee cups. Alternatively, collect the soft plastic waste from lollies and chocolates and deposit to a REDcycle bin post-event.
