N82, NEW ARRIVALS BUILDING

OVERVIEW

Over the next four years, as part of the Nathan Redevelopment Program, a new flagship building (N82) will be developed in the Nathan campus arrivals area on the current N13 site, adjacent to the arrivals area.

The building will create the capacity we need at Nathan to accommodate the closure of Mt Gravatt campus in 2026.

N82 will be a flagship building contributing to the future vision of the Nathan Campus to create a lively and engaging campus that embodies Griffith's core principles and values.

KEY OPPORTUNITIES

The development of N82 is a prime opportunity to involve students, staff, industry and the broader community.

QUICK FACTS

- The building contains 22,000sqm of floor area (almost three times the size of N78 Sir Samuel Griffith Centre)
- Features 9 levels of integrated teaching and learning spaces, with research, industry and staff accommodations
- The main design feature is a central outdoor atrium which extends through the entire building
- Lounge spaces are scattered throughout various levels for informal study and collaboration
