How do we know if cities are adapting to climate change?

Presented by Dr Sean Goodwin

Abstract

Dr Sean Goodwin is a postdoctoral researcher within the IMAGINE Adaptation project; a European Research Council funded project based at the Basque Centre for Climate Change (BC3, Bilbao, ES) that aims to advance progress on monitoring, evaluation, reporting, and learning (MERL) for climate change adaptation. As part of this work, the team is partnering with 12 cities across different world regions to support them in their efforts to define locally relevant definitions of adaptation success, and MERL processes that can help them measure progress towards their goals. The team employs diverse methods to do this that are adapted to local needs, often involving arts-based, future-looking approaches involving city technicians and local communities alike. Sean will present some of the preliminary experiences from his work with partners in Bristol (UK), Toronto (CA), and the Gold Coast (AU)".
