

The program is designed for graduates of any career discipline, as well as those already working in these industries who wish to build upon their existing knowledge base and skills and obtain a formal qualification.

SKILLS	<ul> <li>Graduates of a Graduate Certificate will have:</li> <li>cognitive skills to review, analyse, consolidate and synthesise knowledge and identify and provide solutions to complex problems</li> <li>cognitive skills to think critically and to generate and evaluate complex ideas</li> </ul>	Graduates will be knowledgeable and skilled in case management practice and will have critical reasoning skills, with a particular focus on theory practice integration relevant to personal injury management, employment services or related practice. The program encourages the spirit of critical inquiry and creative innovation informed by current research and professional practice. Effective communication is a core component of this program. Graduates will be able to demonstrate effective oral, written and interpersonal communication skills and will be effective communicators and team members when dealing with clients and relevant stakeholders. They will be equipped to work effectively with diverse groups of people in a wide range of organisations within the personal injury management, employment services and related disciplines.
