Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) for Griffith Team Leaders (GTLs)

Team Registration Compliance:

- Aid in the recruitment process of team(s)
- Ensure all team members are registered for the competition within the specified deadlines
- Confirm that all required documents and forms are accurately completed and submitted

Payment Deadline Adherence:

- Ensure timely submission of team fees and any other related payments
- Verify that payment deadlines are met by all team members

Effective Communication:

- Maintain clear and open communication channels between team members, non-competing officials (NCO's) and Griffith University Team Management (UTMs)
- Participate in monthly (or otherwise organised) regular UTM meetings
- Ensure that all relevant information regarding schedules, meetings, and updates is effectively communicated to team members

Performance Management:

- Organise and attend trials
- Organise and attend regular trainings
- Encourage and support team members to perform at their best during training sessions and competitions
- Provide assistance and guidance to team members to enhance their skills and performance levels
- Facilitate recruitment of selectors, coaches and NCO's

Behaviour and Sportsmanship:

- Uphold high standards of behaviour, conduct, and sportsmanship among team members.
- Address any instances of misconduct or unsportsmanlike behaviour promptly and appropriately
- Report all instances of misconduct or unsportsmanlike behaviour to UTM's immediately

Team Representation:

- Ensure that the team is well represented both on and off the field
- Coordinate with UTM's to address any logistical or administrative issues related to team representation

Attendance and Participation:

- Monitor and assess team members' attendance at trials, practices, meetings, and events
- Encourage and assess the expected full participation and engagement from all team members

Adherence to Policies and Guidelines:

- Ensure compliance with all relevant policies, guidelines, and regulations set forth by Griffith University and the competition organisers

- Stay informed about any updates or changes to policies and communicate them to the team

These KPIs are designed to ensure that GTLs fulfill their responsibilities effectively, contribute to the success of their respective teams, and uphold the values and standards of Griffith University at UniSport Nationals.

 - a. Yes, we will provide a letter of support, please organise this with your course convenors as early as possible. However, we cannot guarantee any acceptance of this letter with your course convenor.

- 4. Is this the same as UniGames?**
 - a. Essentially yes, UniGames was rebranded. The rebrand of the Nationals competition is to focus and emphasise the quality, commitment to and results of the sporting competitions.*
 - b. Although students will have the opportunity to network and socialise within the GU squad as well as with the wider university community the results on the field, court or alike are the number one priority.*
 - i. Any GU squad members who display behaviours or attitudes in contrast to the GU culture will face being excluded or withdrawn from the squad without the possibility of a refund on any monies paid.*
