<b>PURPOSE</b>	The Bachelor Degree qualifies individuals who apply a broad and coherent body of knowledge in a range of contexts to undertake professional work and as a pathway for further learning.		
<b>KNOWLEDGE</b>	Graduates of a Bachelor Degree will have a broad and coherent body of knowledge, with depth in the underlying principles and concepts in one or more disciplines as a basis for independent lifelong learning.	Graduates of the Bachelor of Visual Arts will demonstrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Expression in Visual Arts: Develops visual arts outcomes informed by international and national theoretical, technical and historical discourse in contemporary visual art.</li> <li>• Material Skills: skills in, and knowledge of, diverse forms of artmaking and practice.</li> <li>• Critical Reflection: Engages reflexively with visual arts discourse and criticism to evaluate their own work and the work of others.</li> <li>• Self-direction: Capability to conceive, research, develop and produce visual arts projects independently.</li> <li>• Research skills and capabilities: Identifies relevant and appropriate sources of information, research, and practice.</li> <li>• Cultural awareness: Recognises and reflects on diverse social, cultural, and ethical issues particularly in relation to Indigenous protocols.</li> <li>• Communication &amp; Collaboration Skills: Capabilities to work collaboratively - integrating and interpreting ideas and feedback, communicating and presenting in diverse contexts.</li> <li>• Professional capabilities: understands the roles, contexts, professional practices &amp; working environments of contemporary art with an ability to seek and secure professional opportunities.</li> </ul>
