4.0 DURATION OF PRIZE

5.0 ELIGIBILITY OF PRIZE

Awarded to a Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University student completing a Bachelor of Music degree, majoring in Guitar for the best overall performance.

Students who have won the first prize on one previous occasion are not eligible.

6.0 SELECTION PROCESS

All competitors are required to play their own choice of works lasting not longer than 12 minutes in duration.

Judges are to be appointed by the Director (or their nominee).

No judge may be the teacher of student who is competing.

7.0 ADMINISTRATION OF THE PRIZE

The Queensland Conservatorium, Griffith University will be responsible for the administration of the prize including the publicising of the prize and managing funds associated with the prize.
