1.0 NAME OF COMPETITION

1.1 Ross Peters 4MBS Chamber Music Prize

2.0 DONOR OF PRIZE

2.1 4MBS - Classic FM, in memory of founding member, Mr Ross Peters

3.0 NATURE OF PRIZE

- 3.1 In 2025 the total prize fund will be \$250
- 3.2 The winning group may be recorded at a later date for possible broadcast on 4MBS Classic FM and will be given a copy of the recording.

4.0 DURATION OF PRIZE

4.1 The prize is to be offered on an annual basis.

5.0 ELIGIBILITY OF PRIZE

5.1 Awarded to a Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University student chamber group (minimum 3 players) for the best performance.

6.0 SELECTION PROCESS

- 6.1 Repertoire is free choice and performance duration must be between 10-15 minutes. Single movements of multi-movement works are permitted.
- 6.2 All applicants must submit a video of the ensemble playing one movement/short piece for shortlisting, if necessary
- 6.3 Shortlisted participants will be advised not later than Friday 21 November
- 6.4 The judges are to include two people appointed by the Director (or nominee) and one person appointed by 4MBS Classic FM.

7.0 ADMINISTRATION OF THE PRIZE

7.1 The Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University will be responsible for the administration of the prize, including the publicising of the prize and liaison with 4MBS Classic FM
