**Note:** Screenshots in this guide may differ depending on device and software versions.



## Microsoft Edge

**1** In a browser window, click on the **three dots ...** (located at the top-right of the browser window)

**2** Select **Help and feedback**

**3** Select **About Microsoft Edge**.

If you are prompted to restart your Microsoft Edge browser, please do so right away.




## Google Chrome

**1** In a browser window, click on the **three dots ...** (located at the top-right of the browser window)

**2** Select **Help**.

**3** Select **About Google Chrome**.

If you are prompted to restart your Google Chrome browser, please do so right away.




# Safari (MacOS)

If a Safari browser update is available for your device, you can get it by updating or upgrading your MacOS device.

To check and install any updates or upgrades to that are available for your MacOS device follow the steps below.

## If you have VenturaOS or later installed:


- 1 Click on the Apple menu and select **System Settings**.



- 2 On the left-hand menu click **General** and select **Software Update**.


If Software Update finds new software:

- Click **More info** to view what updates are available
- Click **Update Now** to install available updates.



## If you have MontereyOS or earlier installed


- 1 Click on the Apple menu and select **System Preferences**.



- 2 Click **Software Update**.

If Software Update finds new software:

- Click **More info** to view what updates are available
- Click **Update Now** button to install available updates.




# Safari (iOS)

If a Safari browser update is available for your device, you can get it by updating or upgrading your iOS or iPadOS device. To check and install any updates or upgrades to that are available for your iOS device:


- 1 Open **Settings**.



- 2 Scroll down and select **General**.



- 3 Select **Software Update**.



- 4 If Software Update finds new software, click **Download and Install** to install it.



# Firefox

- 1 In a browser window, click on the **hamburger menu** (located at the top-right of the browser window)

- 2 Select **Help** then **About Firefox**.

- 3 Firefox will automatically check and download any updates.

If you are prompted to restart your Firefox browser after an update has downloaded, please do so right away.
